

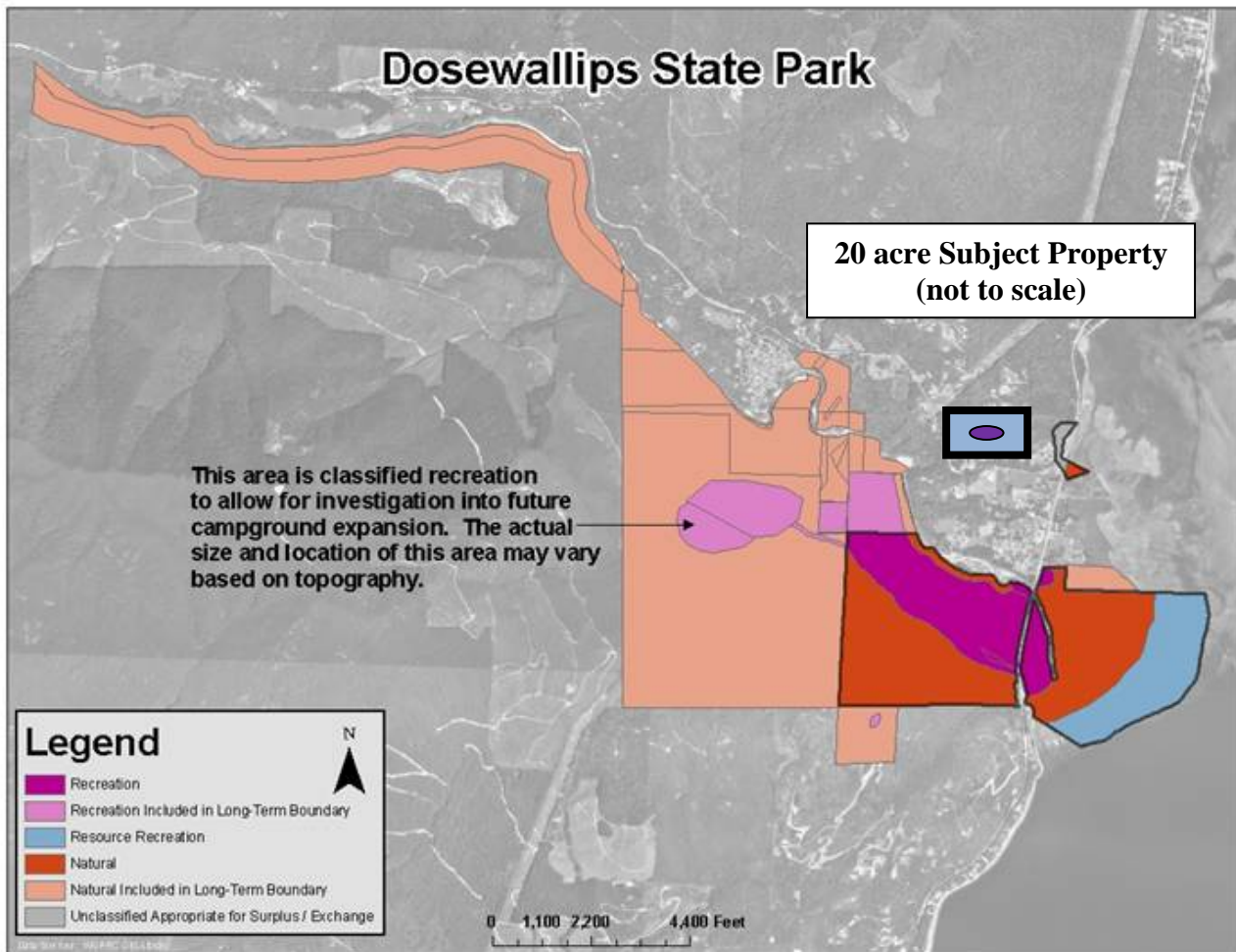
This document is an addendum to the environmental checklist for the existing Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) issued for the *Dosewallips State Park Area Land Classification and Long-Term Boundary Plan* on April 13, 2006. This addendum is being provided pursuant to WAC 197-11-600 and WAC 197-11-625. **It has been determined that this new information does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental document.** The original SEPA documents and additional background information related to this proposal are available on the agency's website at <http://www.parks.wa.gov/plans/dose/>. A description of the proposed change is included below.

Although there is no comment period required for the proposed action all comments are welcome and will be considered. You may also provide testimony at the May 6, 2010 regularly scheduled Commission meeting at the Montesano City Hall located at 112 North Main Street, Montesano, WA. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m.

Description of the proposed change:

The proposed long-term park boundary for Dosewallips State Park is revised to include a 20 acre parcel (the former Jorgensen property – Jefferson County Parcel #602353005) located north of the existing State Park boundary, as shown below. Approximately three acres in the center of this heavily treed parcel will be used to site a waste water treatment system capable of producing water suitable for reuse. Treated water will be infiltrated on-site to provide aquifer recharge. The balance of the 20 acre parcel will remain treed and provide sufficient buffer area to screen adjacent large lot (5 acre) residential parcels from the proposed use.

The revised proposal either has no effect or reduces potential environmental impacts identified in the environmental documentation prepared for the previous proposal.
