

Draft Environmental Impact Statement Notice

Washington State Parks is preparing a draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) covering a Master Facilities Plan for Mount Spokane State Park.

The document will be posted here as soon as it is available for public review, approximately mid September.

It will cover expected new facilities, programs and operations at Mount Spokane State Park for the next 20 years. A 30 day comment period will be provided. Printed copies will be at several Spokane Public Libraries and the park office. Electronic copies will be available on request.

A public meeting will be held in the Spokane area to accept public comments.

The EIS will NOT include operation or potential expansion of the Mount Spokane Ski and Snowboard Park facilities; that will be addressed in a separate document at a later date.
