

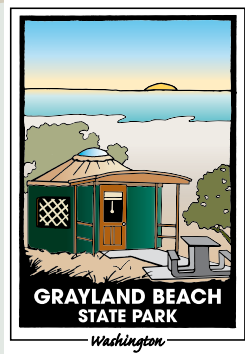
# Grayland Beach State Park



**G**rayland Beach State Park is a year-round, 468-acre camping park, featuring ocean beach, dunes and dense thickets of shore pine. Popular activities include bird watching, seasonal shellfishing, surfing, fishing, kite flying and winter storm watching.

## Park amenities and facilities

- Four standard campsites, four primitive campsites, 60 full-hookup sites and 42 utility sites with water and electrical hookup.
- Fourteen yurts with heat, lights, bunk bed, futon bed, end table, a covered porch and a fire pit. Each sleeps five comfortably.
- One trailer dump station.
- Four restrooms and eight showers.

## Things to remember

- **Hours** – Parks are generally open 6:30 a.m. to dusk.
- **Winter schedule** – Although most parks are open year round, some parks or portions of parks are closed during the winter. For a winter schedule and information about seasonal closures, visit [www.parks.wa.gov](http://www.parks.wa.gov) or call the information center at (360) 902-8844.
- **Wildlife, plants and all park buildings, signs, tables and other structures are protected; removal or damage of any kind is prohibited. Hunting, feeding of wildlife and gathering firewood on state park property is prohibited.**
- **One camping party is allowed per site. Maximum of eight people per campsite.**
- **Campsites may not be held for other parties.**
- **Camping check-in time is 2:30 p.m., and check-out time is 1 p.m.**
- **Pets must be on leash and under physical control at all times. This includes trail areas and campsites. Pet owners must clean up after pets on all state park lands.**
- **Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.**
