1	Assemble and install two map and information kiosks. Place kiosks at specific trail locations to enhance user orientation.	April 2 10am – noon.	Gloves; appropriate clothing for the project and weather; water; snacks	
2	Trail maintenance: Widen Kettle Trail by salal brushing.	April 9 10am – noon.	Gloves, loppers or shears; appropriate clothing for the project and weather; water; snacks	
3	Scotch Broom removal. Cut and remove invasive weeds from day use area and bluff trail. Prevent the spread of invasive plant species that displace grassland habitat and outcompetes native plants. Invasive plants pose a fire hazard due to its volatile oils.	April 16 10 am – noon.	Gloves and loppers; appropriate clothing for the project and weather; water; snacks
