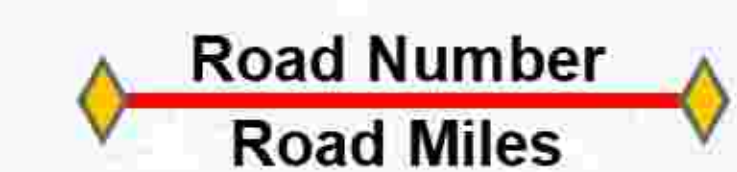


Welcome Teanaway / 29 Pines Staging Area **Groomed Trail System**
