
## Washington State Parks Centennial GeoTour

100 caches in 100 parks to celebrate 100 years!

- 1. Visit the GeoTour page www.geocaching.com/adventures/geotours/washington-state-parks to see the list of qualifying caches in Washington state parks. All caches have the series name "WaStatePks100."
- 2. Visit the parks, discover the geocaches and record your finds in this passport using the unique ink stamp inside each cache.
- 3. Once you've found 50 qualifying caches, you can turn in your passport and receive a silver Washington State Parks

geocoin (trackable on geocaching.com). If you find a full century of caches (100), you qualify for the rare gold geocoin (only 30 available).

- 4. To receive your coin, fill out the back of this passport, then mail it to Cama Beach State Park, 1880 SW Camano Drive, Camano Island, WA 98282. Once your stamps are verified, your coin will be mailed to you.
- 5. Be sure to read the full challenge rules at www.parks.wa.gov/geocaching.

All stamps must be on a single passport, unless you are doing the 100-cache challenge, in which case you may submit one passport with 50 stamps to receive the silver coin, and a second one with the remaining 50 stamps to win your gold coin.

6. A Discover Pass is required to park at all state parks.
